No adventure is complete without a hearty breakfast and great coffee. Make a pit stop at The Taste and See Restaurant to give your excursion the proper fuel.



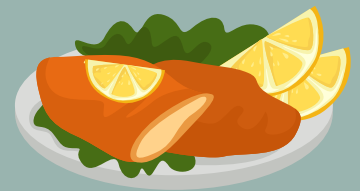
If you're craving an adrenaline packed activity, book an excursion with Ascent NB for a guided day of ice climbing at Parlee Brook Amphitheatre.
